A Better Culture Advisory Board had their first meeting on Monday 27th November. There was strong endorsement of the proposed Phase 2 work program.

The implementation and intent of the Framework and themes was unequivocally endorsed. This is in no small part due to the detailed review of our drafts that so many of our reference group chairs and members undertook, which resulted in comprehensive, actionable recommendations that the Board felt comfortable to accept.

This brings Phase One of the project to a close.

Phase 2 will entail establishing 5 working groups and we will circulate the finalized version of Phase 2 work plan by Mid-December. Reference groups will remain critical partners for Phase 2. Reference group leaders and membership can expect an update on communications from our team no later than the December 20th.
